



European Diploma of Medical Physics (EDMP)

Fees

Any candidate applying for the EDMP will be charged the €350 'first attempt fee'. In the event of a candidate failing the first attempt, any subsequent attempts will be charged €290. At this point, we are unable to offer any financial aid but EEB will continue to work to identify ways to provide financial aid to assist in examinations costs.

- The examination fee is reduced by 20 % for those applying for EDMP in a 2nd or 3rd sub-specialty.
- Full payment must have been received by the application deadline of the relevant examination. Only applications for which full payment has been received will be accepted.
- If you do not meet the eligibility criteria, the EEB will not accept your application and your examination fee will be refunded. Refunds cannot be provided in other cases, for example in case of incomplete applications or if an applicant withdraws his/her application.
- Please note that EEB examinations have a limited number of positions. Examination places are assigned on a "first-come first-served" basis.
