Scientific Vice Chair ((will take office as chair in January 2027 for 2 years)	January 2026

Please note that the posts of President and Secretary General are not eligible for re-election. Since the treasurer has served two terms this position must also be elected.

Therefore, it is our pleasure to invite your National Member Organisation to submit nominations for the five positions listed. Nominations should be submitted to the Secretary General [secretary@efomp.org](mailto:secretary@efomp.org) by the President of the NMO, together with:

- o A formal letter of nomination including the name and affiliation of the nominee, and the names of the Proposer and Secunder of the nomination. The letter of nomination should include a statement on why the President of the NMO believes the nominee is suitable for the position on the board of EFOMP keeping in mind the skills required.
- o A letter from the candidate accepting his/her nomination
- o A statement (up to 500 words) by the candidate in relation to the post for which he/she is nominated demonstrating a knowledge and interest in this position and highlighting any other experience which makes them suitable for the post such as soft skills; the ability to lead, inspire, manage timely, work as part of a team for a common goal, effectively communicate, mediate conflicts and find solutions, build relations with





- affiliated organisations and stakeholders, understanding financial planning and ensure funds are used effectively, execute long term strategies and have a clear vision for the future of the society.
- o A short Curriculum Vitae of the candidate (limited to 3 pages PDF)

Nominations should reach the Secretary General no later than 10th of May 2025, 24.00 CET. Should you require additional information, please do not hesitate to contact the Secretary General or President of EFOMP.
